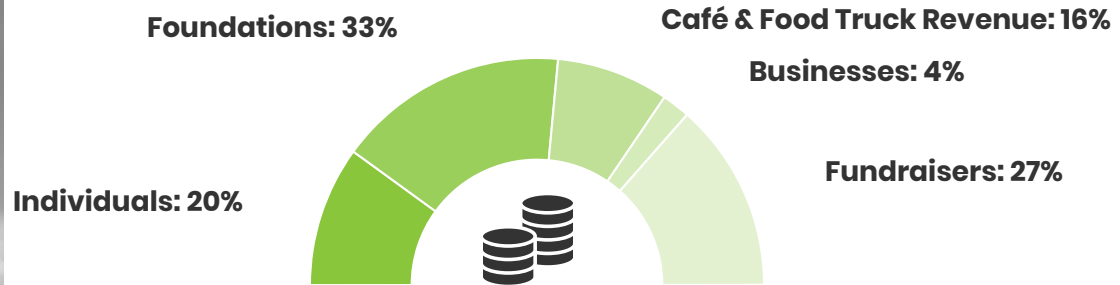

PROGRAMS

SAME Café

The flagship program of So All May Eat has been around for nearly 14 years. Each year hundreds of volunteers, dozens of gardens and farms, and the incredible staff serve delicious meals to everyone, regardless of ability to pay.

SAME Food Truck

The pay-what-you-can mobile cafe served 3,805 healthy meals in food insecure neighborhoods throughout Denver Metro this first year and has helped develop partnerships to broaden the conversation about food insecurity.

Cook to Work

Our flexible job training program allows people to get food service skills training on their own schedule while volunteering at SAME. We have enrolled 27 people in the program and have assisted 9 folks in securing employment.

SAME Garden

So All May Eat partners with MetroCaring to run a community garden plot that will grow food for the Café and Food Truck and provide hands-on gardening skills to volunteers
